

Creeping St Peter Tree Warden Report

Annual Parish Council meeting 15.5.2017

Set up Village Wildlife Group to increase awareness of existing habitats and to act to improve areas.

Recently contacted by a parishoner as they were concerned that a walnut tree over 80 years old was going to be cut down by the council. I contacted Alice Martin assistant tree officer who investigated the matter and assured me that the tree may only need some maintenance work.

The intention is that theses trees will be dedicated at the Parish lunch.
