CSP093/15 POLICE REPORT

PC Stefan Henriksen emailed the clerk stating the following:-

"I wanted to make you aware of some of the changes within the SNT's in Suffolk that will have an impact on the communities we work with. With the impact of budget cuts in the constabulary, there are certain changes that have become necessary, so that we can manage the core areas of policing. One of these directions is that we are no longer able to routinely attend parish council meetings (or other meetings), or to provide reports. If there is a particular issue within an area or part of a community, we will of course attend/update as necessary. Should members of the public require a summary of their local area, crime statistics are easily available from – www.police.uk

I remain your local officer, as does Ben Ellis and will always be contactable by phone or e-mail and there will be no change in that. I will do my best to make sure there is as little impact on the Creeting St Peter community as possible, and aim to provide the same service."

CSP094/15 DISTRICT COUNCILLOR REPORT – CLLR KEITH WELHAM – see attached report

Cllr Keith Welham was unable to attend the meeting but in his report he stated that his locality budget was £5,000 which would be available to assist projects within their wards. If there were any groups or individuals within Creeting St Peter who would benefit from some financial assistance for setting up a new community project or extending the work of an existing community group then contacting Cllr Welham would be the first step that was needed to be taken.

After a brief discussion it was agreed to leave things as they were.
